To advance its mission of providing research, development and education activities benefiting the beef cattle industry and the Charolais breed, the American Charolais Foundation (ACF) will provide graduate student scholarships to young men and women connected to the Charolais breed.

With an initial gift from QuestMark Information Management, Inc., Charolais breeders Larry and Beth Ludeke of Bar J Charolais, Liverpool, Texas and the Evelyn Gay Duhon Family of JVS Cattle Co., Sulphur, Louisiana, seek to provide professional awards annually to veterinary or medical students with the \$4,000 Russell W. Ludeke – Harold Christopher Truax II Memorial Award.

Russell W. Ludeke – Harold Christopher Truax II Memorial Award Qualifications

- 1. Eligible applicants for this veterinary or medical student professional scholarship must be enrolled in an accredited veterinary medicine or medical institution.
- 2. Applicants must currently be or have relation to an American-International Charolais Association member.
- 3. Applications will be scored by the ACF Board of Directors.
- 4. The number and amount of scholarship awards shall be determined each year by the selection committee.
- 5. Application evaluation criteria includes academic excellence, financial need, leadership and interest in the cattle industry.
- 6. The award winner will be announced at American-International Charolais Association Fall Board Meeting and events in Kansas City, Missouri.
- 7. If selected to receive this award, the scholarship applicant will be required to verify their enrollment in the veterinary or medical student professional program in an institution of higher education before the scholarship award check can be issued.
